





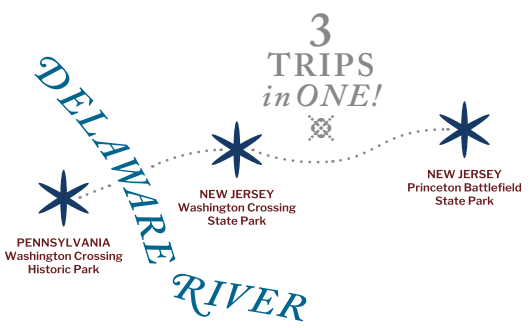

RESCUING The REVOLUTION FIELD TRIP




TAKE YOUR STUDENTS ON A HISTORIC JOURNEY BACK TO THE AMERICAN REVOLUTION!

Our tour begins in Washington Crossing Historic Park, PA and ends at Princeton Battlefield State Park in NJ.

In Washington Crossing, PA students will learn about life in a Continental Army encampment and Washington's daring crossing of the Delaware on Christmas Night 1776!

In Washington Crossing, NJ students will learn about Washington's landing, the battles at Trenton and see real artifacts from the Swan Revolutionary War Collection. Participants will also get to see a musket firing demonstration!

At Princeton, NJ students will explore the historic Thomas Clarke House and key sections of the original battlefield. Interpreters will bring history to life with riveting stories from British and American soldiers who fought there.
